Dear Rev. Fathers / Sisters / Brothers / Lay Faithful,

Peace of Christ!

1. RELIEF TO THE FLOOD AFFECTED OF KODAGU AND KERALA

Tragedies and natural calamities are part of our life, but we really pity those have been affected by them. The unprecedented rains, floods and landslides in Kodagu and Kerala shook us all. Though many may question why God does permit such natural calamities to happen, it is meaningful also to note that as in the Bible God raises Noahs and Moses' amongst us in such situations. The super human efforts of our soldiers and navy pilots, and the added rescue operations of the poor fishermen with their boats will go down in history as examples of the indomitable spirit of Indian people, especially in times of tragedies and human calamities.

"We have nothing to fear, when you are with us" reads a motivational appeal in the print media. The Archdiocese too has responded, and thanks to the overwhelming response to the emergency meeting called at the Archbishop's House a few days ago. A task force called **Bangalore Archdiocesan Flood Relief Committee (BAFC)** has been formed, drawn of members from among the Priests, Religious and other individuals from dedicated NGOs of Bangalore. Further to our appeals, many have responded with things and articles including food items and clothing which are already sent to flood affected areas of Kodagu and Kerala.

After the immediate relief comes the rehabilitation, by way of repairing and re-constructing of thousands of houses, schools and other places of habitation. It is here that we can pool our resources to lend them our helping hand. Consequent to our appeal, our Parishes and Churches have already sent and some are sending the proceeds of the collections made in our Churches for this purpose on Sunday, 26th August 2018.

I appeal to the Managements (both Archdiocesan and Religious) of our Schools, Colleges and other allied institutions to make strong collections from among their students and the public, as the public will understand that these tragedies affect all categories of people, irrespective of caste and creed. The children can also be requested to contribute as they will have a natural and spontaneous wave of sympathy for the children in the affected areas, since in such tragedies, the ones who unfortunately bear most the brunt are the children and women who are most vulnerable. I suggest that we motivate the Staff of our Institutions too to contribute at least a day's salary for this noble cause.

Please send your monetary support by way of cheques or NEFT transfers to the Archdiocesan Curia (Cheque: In the name of Archdiocese of Bangalore or Director BMSSS Society) by 15th Sept.2018. It will be faithfully transmitted to CARITAS INDIA, which is monitoring the relief work along with the Governmental agencies. We have even informed the CARITAS INDIA that the Bangalore Archdiocesan collection to be sent to an identifiable relief or rehabilitation project in a definite area of Kodagu/Kerala.

2. FEAST OF THE NATIVITY OF MOTHER MARY – 8TH SEPTEMBER 2018

All roads in Bangalore lead to St. Mary's Basilica, Shivaji Nagar, on the 8th September, and even during the novena days. To see thousands of people coming to this pilgrimage centre is indeed incredible and a source of inspiration to all of us, especially to notice the devotion manifested to Mother Mary by the non-Christians. In a way it poses challenges to us as to how to feed the crowds with the real "*Bread of Life*" and the "*Word of God.*" I appeal to the Priests and Religious of the Archdiocese to be part of the "providers" of the

Bread and the Word. I understand the conveniences for the pilgrims are not optimum. Let what we have to offer them be not just the superficial spiritual and emotional nourishment, but an opportunity for them to experience the love of God through Mother Mary. The Priests in particular are requested to sit for confessions to help reconcile the pilgrims with God.

3. CENSUS OF THE CATHOLIC FAMILIES IN THE ARCHDIOCESE

Everyone feels the need to be counted, attended to and even appreciated. While some Parishes have taken the trouble to conduct census of their parishioners, others have not been able to do. Many of our people continue to be faceless individuals in our parishes. A good census also helps us to identify the people, their status and needs, so as to plan better our pastoral and spiritual services. We also have to remember that Bangalore has a large floating population who have come here for jobs or education. Besides, there are the migrants who need to be included in our pastoral services.

Common census forms will be sent from the Archdiocese by the end of September to be compiled by the Parishes with the help of the Parish Council, Lay Association or SCC members. Our data entry team, headed by Fr. Sunny Richard, Secretary of Family Commission, will expect the forms back by end of November 2018. The census forms of the Migrants, which were taken earlier may also be sent to us. Otherwise, fresh forms may be used to fill in the data.

4. ELECTIONS FOR THE COUNCIL OF PRIESTS

The Council of Priests in the Archdiocese is a statutory body consisting of Priests, who come from the Ex-officio Status, Elected or Nominated Categories. The elections for this august body will be held during the time of the Deanery Recollection on 19th September 2018 in all the deaneries.

5. THE ARCHDIOCESAN AND DEANERY RECOLLECTIONS FOR PRIESTS

As discussed at the last Archdiocesan Recollection on 13th August, the Recollections for Priests and Religious working in the

Archdiocesan parishes and institutions will be held every month on the same day, that is, on 3rd Wednesday of the month. The recollection on the Archdiocesan level will be held once in three months on the 3rd Wednesdays.

It is meaningful for us Priests to participate in these recollections that will animate us spiritually and, at the same time, create a bond of unity in the Presbyterium in the service of our people. It is convenient also to discuss the problems of the area at the deanery level and seek suggestions and support from each other. I request all the Priests to be present at these recollections that will take place at the Deanery level as well as at the Archdiocesan level on the below-mentioned days in the Archdiocese. Like any other Institution, it had a humble beginning. But during the past years, due to the initiatives, support and encouragement of my Predecessors, especially Archbishop Emeritus Bernard Moras, and the Past Heads of the Institution and the Staff, this Institution has grown considerably. It was started with the 3rd Std., and only in the later years, the students were admitted to 1st Standard.

In the course of the past 75 years, many other institutions were added to it, namely

St. Germain's Pre-University College (2005); St. Germain's Nursery Section was started in 2012 and the Co-ED System was introduced; St. Germain's Computer Academy (2013); St. Germain's Community College (2016); St. Germain's Sports Academy (2017); and St. Germain's Coaching Centre (2018).

As St. Germain's has SEVEN Institutions in this Campus having all the facilities, the basic infra-structure and the required staff, and also in compliance with the request of the Advisory Committee of this Institution, it is but fitting that it is declared as An Academy during its Platinum Jubilee Year. Hence, I am pleased to rename it as St. Germain's Academy from 1st September, 2018.

I take this opportunity to congratulate all those who were instrumental, both the past and the present Administration, in bringing this Institution to this present status.
